Question 1:

What was most compelling to you from the *Student Stories of Climate Change* Day-1 presentation? (What did you learn, what surprised you, were any of your preconceptions about Climate Change challenged?)

Question 2:

Which Day-1 Student Story of Climate Change did you find most compelling and why?

Question 3:

How might Climate Change affect you, your family, or community in the future?

Question 4: What aspect of Climate Change do you want to learn more about?

What stood out to you from that story? What are the similarities and differences between their struggles with Climate Change, and those faced by Americans?
Question 6: Imagine you are speaking to someone who doesn't believe in Climate Change. How would you explain the science of Climate Change to them? How might you respond if they don't believe in the validity of your information? What sources and facts would you use to support your argument?
